Boost Your Professional Presence by Earning ENP-C

In 2016, with support from our physician colleagues, AAENP partnered with the American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Certification Board to develop a national board certification exam for nurse practitioners in emergency care. First offered in January 2017, the ENP certification (ENP-C) is a post-graduate Family NP specialty examination. This certification program aligns with the APRN Consensus Model for specialty nursing practice and meets national accreditation standards.

AAENP has defined practice standards that describe emergency nurse practitioners' clinical knowledge, skills and competencies, and serve as the foundation for the **ENP certification by examination** established in 2017. These practice standards establish a baseline for clinical ENP privileges, organizational onboarding, evaluation, education and training for hospitals, clinical practice leaders and quality assurance teams. They also provide benchmarks for professional achievement and advancement.
